Save the date!

It has been a while – December 2017! - since the CCM project issued the last newsletter. Indeed, the project team was extremely busy with updating the common Nordic Capacity Calculation Methodology (CCM) for the Nordic Capacity Calculation Region, based on the Request for Amendment that they received from the National Regulatory Authorities.

Just to remind you... On September 15, 2017, the Nordic TSOs have submitted their common Nordic Capacity Calculation Methodology (CCM) for the Nordic Capacity Calculation Region to the NRAs. The proposal is the following.

For the **Day Ahead** timeframe: The Nordic TSOs propose to implement a flow-based capacity calculation approach for the Day Ahead Market timeframe.

For the **Intraday** timeframe: As the long-term solution, the Nordic TSOs propose to implement a flow-based approach for the intraday timeframe, as soon as the intraday market platform is technically able to utilize flow-based capacities. As an interim solution, the Nordic TSOs propose to implement a coordinated net transmission capacity approach for the intraday market timeframe.

On March 16, the TSOs received a Request for Amendment from the National Regulatory Authorities. The Nordic TSOs are in the process of updating their common Nordic Capacity Calculation Methodology (CCM) for the Nordic Capacity Calculation Region accordingly. It has been submitted to the National Regulatory Authorities on May 16.

In the June 13 Stakeholder Group meeting, we will inform the members of the Stakeholder Group on the amendments made.

Furthermore, the Nordic RSC – supported by the CCM project team members – started with the specification of the IT requirements of the CCM methodologies developed by the CCM project. The development of the forward capacity calculation methodology will be initiated shortly.
