THE NORDIC CAPACITY CALCULATION METHODOLOGY PROJECT

In this newsletter, we would like to update you with the progress of the Nordic CCM project and the upcoming stakeholder events.

Implementation timeline of the DA flow-based methodology

The start of external parallel run in November 2021 is not feasible.

Instead, the external parallel run is expected to start early 2022, and the Nordic CCM project will come back to the stakeholders with a more detailed timeline in the coming weeks. The reason for the delay is that ensuring sufficient quality of the input data and the validation of the capacity calculation results have taken longer than anticipated.

Progress of the internal parallel run

Input data delivery has reached a stable ground. Our current focus is on improving the input data quality, validating the capacity calculation results and assessing the market simulation results. Based on the market simulation results, the Nordic TSOs will continue to improve the quality of the input data.
