

Subject: Upcoming Go-Live for Year-Ahead Capacity Calculations – 31 October 2025

Dear Market Participants and other relevant stakeholders,

We are pleased to inform you that the Nordic Long-Term Capacity Calculation (LTCC) project is approaching a significant milestone.

Go-Live of Year-Ahead Capacity Calculations

We are targeting to go live with **Year-Ahead (Y-1)** flow-based capacity calculations on **31 October 2025**. This marks the first coordinated long-term flow-based capacity calculation for the Nordic region – in alignment with FCA Regulation (EU) 2016/1719.

This represents a major step forward in enhancing transparency, efficiency, and coordination in the long-term timeframe.

Month-Ahead (M-1) and Improvements to NUCS

In parallel, we are preparing the foundation for **Month-Ahead (M-1)** flow-based capacity calculations, and are also planning improvements to the **Nordic Unavailability Collection System (NUCS)**.

As part of the LTCC implementation, enhancements to NUCS will focus on ensuring that market participants have timely and reliable access to outage-related information based on long term flow-based calculation results, further supporting operational readiness and transparency.
